ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the 'Best Practices Award' was instituted to reward those who have achieved excellent results in good governance and successfully implemented strategies, new initiatives and best practices. The award carries a cash reward of Rs.2.00 lakhs each for three chosen nominations.

2. Nominations for the Best Practices Award are received under three categories, viz., (i) Government employees – individual; (ii) Government employees – as a group; and (iii) Organisation / Institution / Office.

3. For the year 2017, 20 (twenty) nominations were received and the Screening Committee for the award in its meeting held on 21.07.2017 under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Finance Department scrutinised the nominations and has recommended ten nominations. Further, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department has recommended 3 nominations, out of which one nomination was recommended by the Screening Committee. The 11(eleven) nominations recommended by the Screening Committee were placed before the Selection Committee in its meeting held on 28.07.2017 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government. The Selection Committee scrutinised the nominations for the "Best Practices Award" under the categories of

Individual and Organisation. The Committee after detailed deliberations unanimously decided to recommend the following three nominations for the Best Practices Award-2017.

- i. Tamil Nadu Police Housing Corporation Limited for use of Industrial by-products for manufacturing paver blocks and bricks
- ii. Director of Agriculture for Risk Management through Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana
- iii. Department of Commercial Taxes for Implementation of 'Total Solutions Project'

4. The Selection Committee has also recommended that as a token of appreciation of the special initiatives taken by (i) Dr. K. Narayanasamy, Head, Department of Hepatology, Madras Medical College in the field of treatment for liver ailments and (ii) Dr. Korlapati Satyagopal, IAS., Commissioner of Revenue Administration in formulating an innovative watering technique useful for tree plantation, a 'Certificate of appreciation' may be given to them during the Independence Day Celebrations by the Hon'ble Chief Minister. The above two officials have submitted nominations for the Best Practices Award under the category of 'Individuals'.

5. Based on the recommendations of the Selection Committee and after careful examination of the nominations, Government have decided that the 'Best Practices Award-2017' be given to the following three initiatives recommended by the Selection Committee and the details of awardees who shall receive the reward amount of Rs.2,00,000/- each are as follows :

- ii. Dr. Korlapati Satyagopal, IAS., Commissioner of Revenue Administration for the innovative watering technique useful for tree plantations.


